



Enrollment Process 2024

Application : To be completed online as early as February. A non-refundable fee of \$150 for the first student, plus \$50 for each additional student, is required. This amount includes your placement testing and interview fees.

Shadow Day: Families may schedule a shadow day for their student(s) in the spring, subject to availability. Shadow days are an opportunity for prospective students to visit our classrooms and experience “a day in the life” at Heritage, along with their (potential) future classmates. Shadow days for rising 1st-8th graders are drop-off only, as it is important for our staff to be able to observe shadow students’ interactions with other adults and peers without a parent present. Kindergarten shadow students must be accompanied by a parent for the duration of their visit.

Placement Testing and Family Interview: After we receive your application, we will contact you with the sign-up link for testing and interview appointments. Testing will take place throughout the spring and summer. At the time of your appointment, we will administer reading, writing and math placement tests to each of your students. We will also meet with you, the parents, to get to know your family, answer your questions about our program, and ensure a mutually beneficial fit.

Registration: After your testing and interview appointment, we will reach out (typically within 3 business days) to provide feedback on your child’s placement and let you know if we’re able to extend an invitation to enroll. We will then email you an enrollment link; your enrollment packet will take about 15 minutes to complete online. The registration fee is \$200 per student, or \$350 maximum per family.

Tuition: \$1900 flat fee for kindergarten. \$500-\$550 per year for 1st-8th grade core and math classes. Tuition for 1st-8th grade electives runs from \$125 to \$250 per class. (See Schedule of Fees for more information.) Tuition is paid through your chosen tuition payment plan using FACTS Management; first payment scheduled for August 1, 2024.

Additional Fees: Required activities fee of \$25 per student and insurance fee of \$20 per family will be added to your total tuition amount.

Note: Curriculum and school supplies are not included in these fees, but must be purchased separately by parents before the school year begins. In addition, we ask for an annual donation of specified **communal supplies**, such as office and cleaning products, paper and plasticware, etc.
